Each year, Marquis Society and Porter Society members make a significant impact at Lafayette by enhancing all areas of the student experience through their leadership-level support.

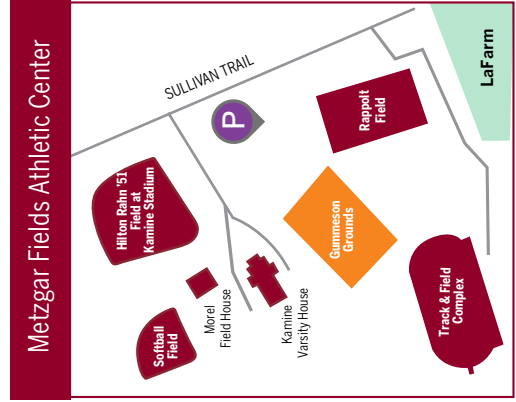
